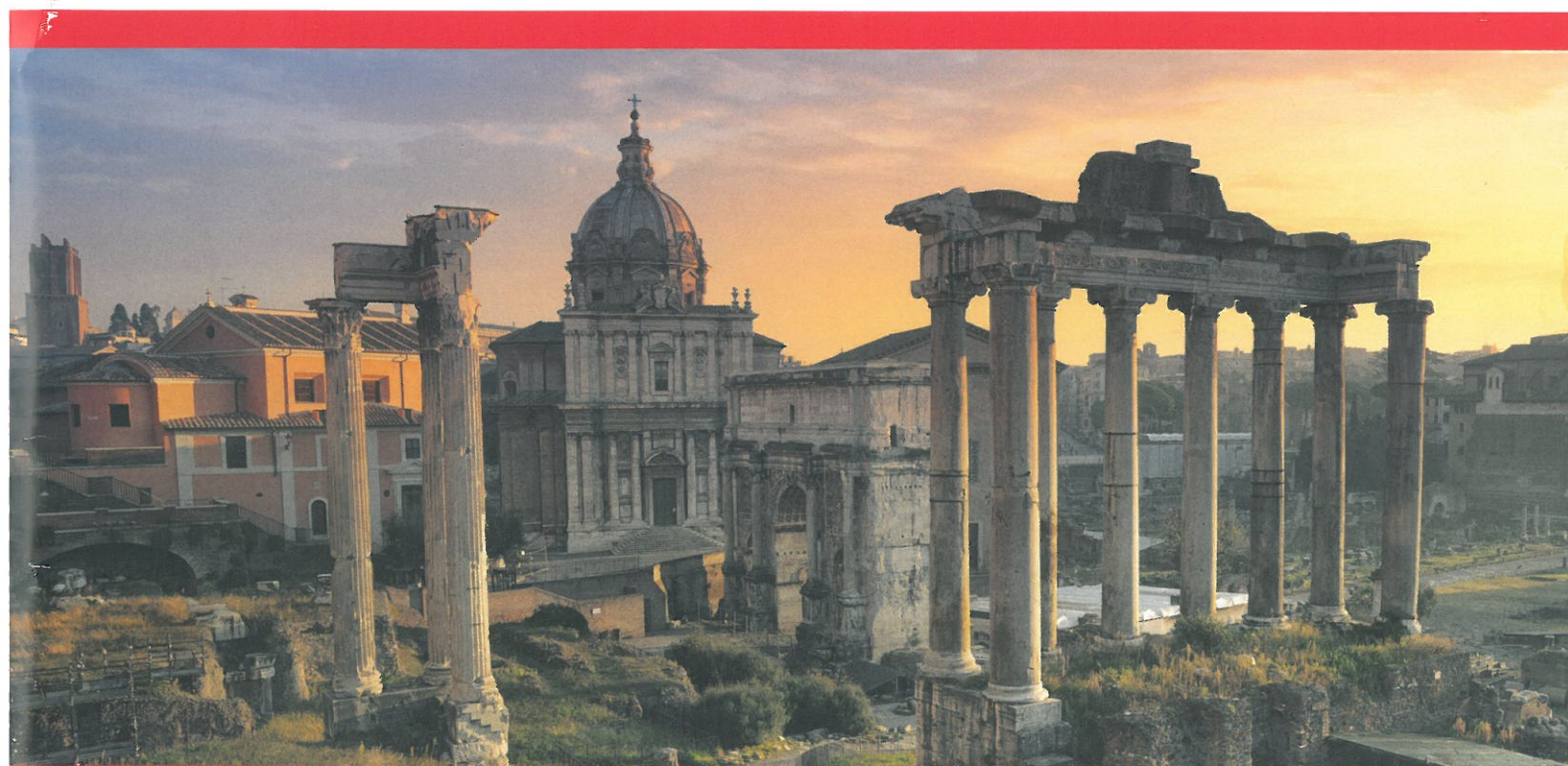

Rome is a cradle of history and art. It is known all over the world as the Eternal City, a synonym for art, history and spirituality. The magnificence and unbelievable number of historical monuments, churches, and museums leave many visitors speechless. TRAVELLING

Rome is served by two international airports, both well connected to the city centre: Leonardo Da Vinci (Fiumicino) and G.B. Pastine (Ciampino). Both hubs are served by the major airline companies, including the low-cost ones. By rail, Rome is well connected with the rest of Italy and Europe by high speed trains which offer the greatest efficiency at low costs. The central railway station, Termini, is in the heart of the historical centre and close to many hotels.
